Your Spring Fayre needs you!

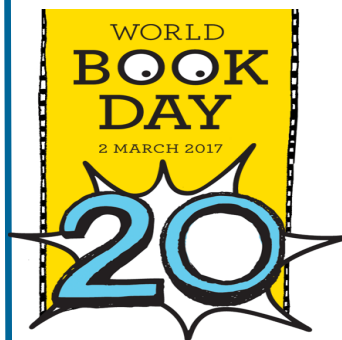
