This also applies to snacks brought into school grounds as this allergy can be airborne and touch sensitive. Some examples of unacceptable foods are peanut butter (including almond butter), Nutella and other chocolate nut spreads, almond milk products, any Kinder chocolate products, marzipan/frangipan, breakfast/granola bars and some breads.
