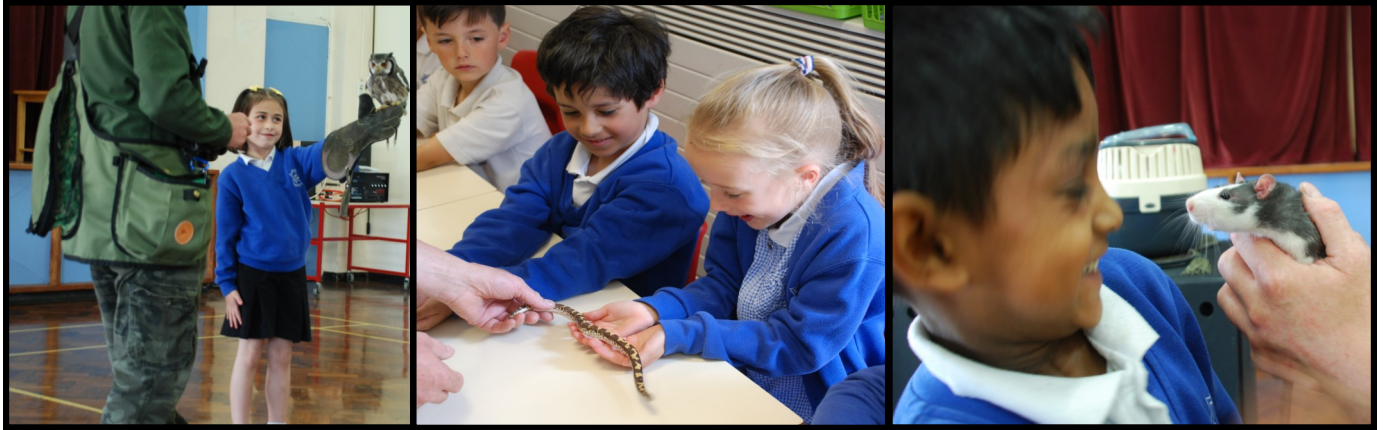




What a hoot ...
