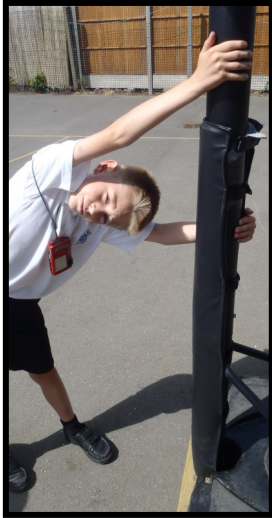




Every picture tells a story
