... and then in Rome ...

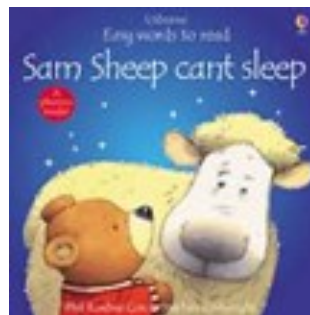
YEAR 4 will be putting on their togas for a day on Monday.
