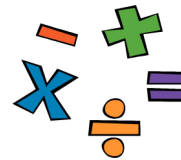




Finding the solution

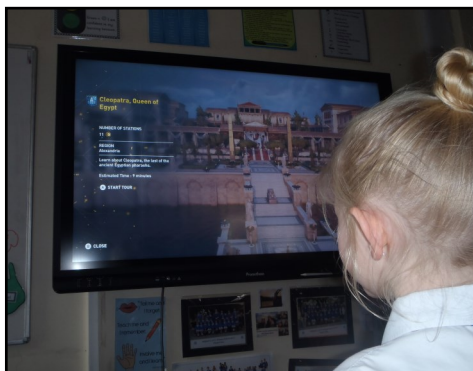
