

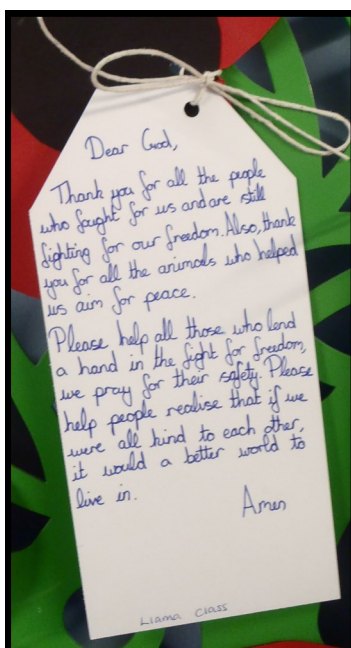
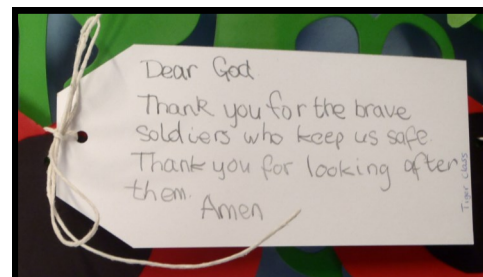


We shall not forget
