## Once a week, take a peak!



WE all know how much headlice like little heads. Don't forget to take a peak once a week at your child's head to keep them pests at bay!

### Where to Peek

- Close to the scalp
- Behind the ears
- The back of the neck
- The top of the head
- Under the fringe

### What to Peek for

- Adult lice are 2-4 mm long  
immature lice are even smaller
- Live lice remain close to the scalp
- Nits are dead or empty egg shells - simply remove these by hand or by combing
