

Geography

We are going to be learning about trade, Mount Etna, Landscapes, temperature, weather trends, landmarks, tourism, Pompeii and Vesuvius.

History

The children are going to understand the chronological studies of:

- The legacy of Roman culture through art, architecture or literature, focusing on later periods in British history, including the present day.
- Famous inventors or Trail Blazers from Italian history. Such as, Leonardo Di Vinci, Marconi, Enzo Ferrari, Galileo Gallilie.
- The Renaissance and the impact on art, literature and science.

Design and Technology

The children will be learning about Italian diet, superfoods and how they are grown. Additionally, they will learn about the functionality and existence of volcanoes.

Art and Design

The children are going to be learning about Renaissance artists and movement by creating Venitian masks linked with celebrations. They will discover famous and significant artists, designers and architects including: Leonado Di Vinci, Marconi, Enzo Ferrari, Galileo Gallilie, Pavarotti.

Computing

Children will gain a greater understanding of how computer networks work can understand computer networks including the internet; how they can provide multiple services, such as the world-wide web; and the opportunities they offer for communication and collaboration.

Science

This term your child will be learning all about Light. They will be learning how light travels in a straight line can recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines. Why we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes.
