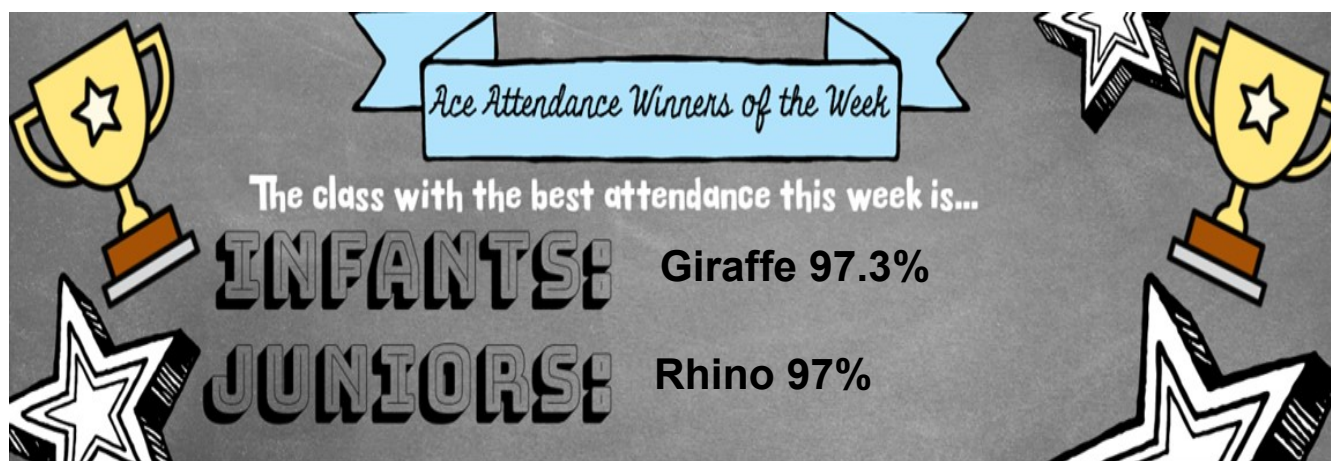
Once a Week, Take a Peek
