



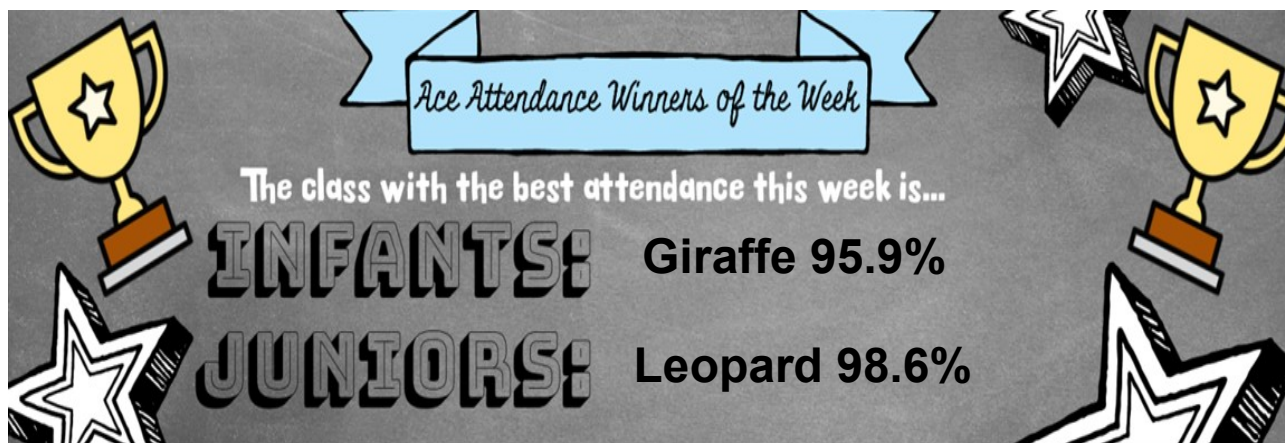
Under the Sea

Medication in School

Free School Meals

CURRENTLY all children from Reception to Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal. Did you also know that if you are in receipt or certain benefits then you may also be able to claim free school meals for your child(ren) and vouchers for the school holidays.



If you think you may be eligible then please provide your name, DOB and NI number to the school office who can run a check.

If you are already claiming free school meals in any capacity please can we ask you to **ONLY** order a meal on Tucasi if your child actually needs one for that day. If you order a meal and then send in a packed lunch then the kitchen cook too much food which is both a waste and comes at a cost to the school.

School Dinners from September

From September the price of a school meal will be increasing to £2.70 per day or £13.50 per week.

School meals should be ordered and paid for in advance at least 1 week before the meal is to be taken. You will be sent a reminder during the summer holidays to book you meals ready for the start of the new school year.
