Year 4 tried false perspective art—here they are in Mrs Lacey's Coffee Cup!

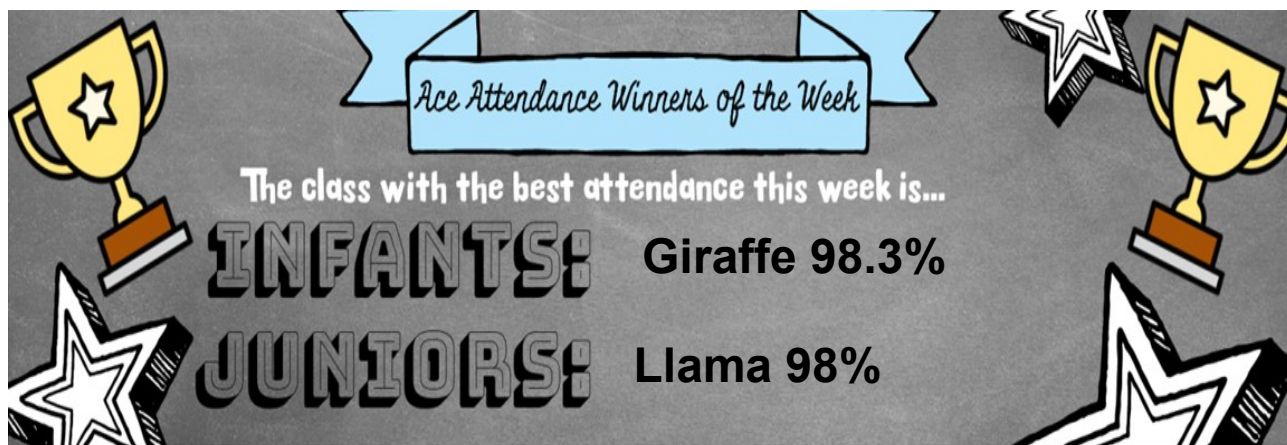
Sweet Angels Singing
