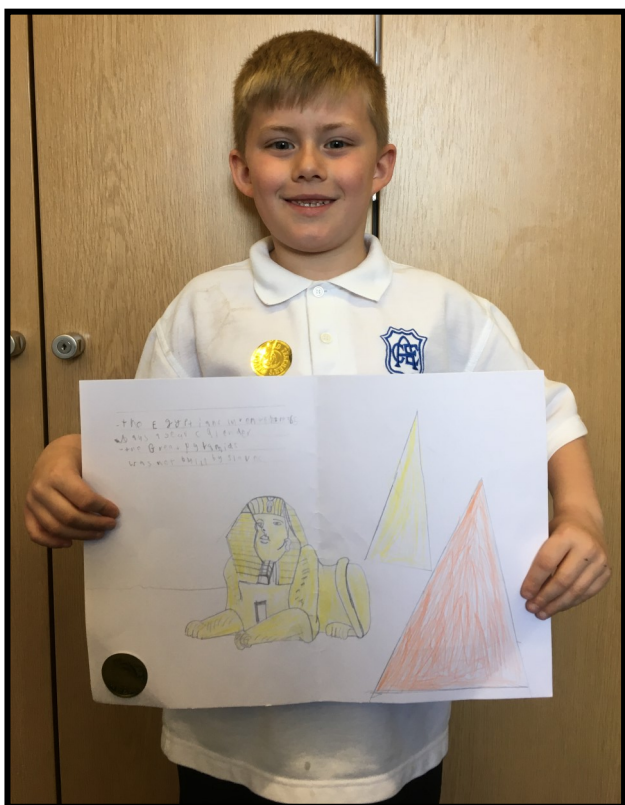

DON'T

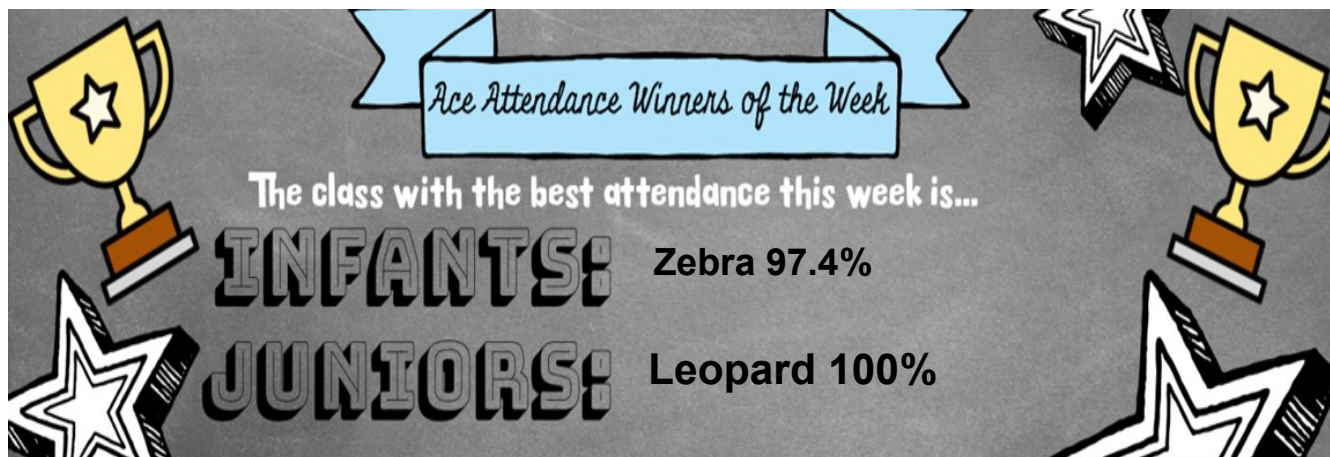
- Park across driveways (we have a disabled neighbour who was unable to get out of her driveway for an appointment recently)
