

# Chess Club

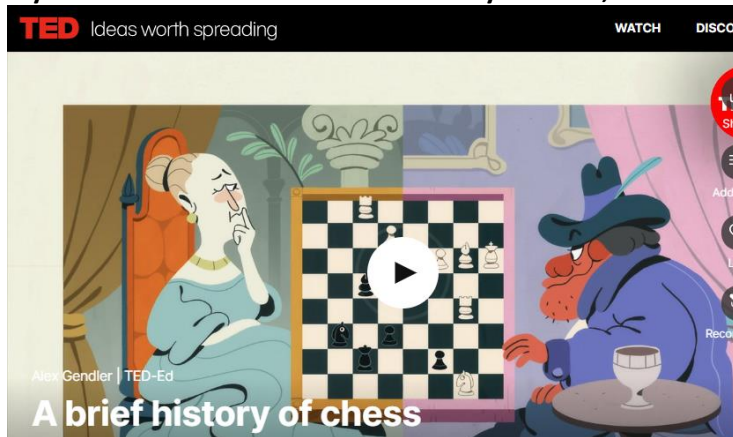
Chess is one of the oldest games in the world. It was probably invented in India more than a thousand years ago, but nobody knows for sure.
