Reading

Remember to read every day for at least 10 minutes. This can be your school book, a book from home, a newspaper, a magazine, a cereal box, a recipe, instructions for a game etc. Please talk to your child about what they have read and ask them to explain what they have understood. Record any reading in their reading record book.

English

We have been learning about tigers and tiger conservation in our theme and English lessons. Please can you listen and watch this story of The Tiger Who Came To Tea.

Now ask your child to imagine what it would be like if a tiger came to tea at their house! What would you do with the tiger? What would the tiger do in your house?

The children can then write a story about an adventure they had with a tiger.

Please remind your children to use capital letters and full stops, finger spaces, conjunctions (but, and, because, or, if) and write in the past tense.



Dexter makes a tally chart of the animals he saw at the zoo



Tick one box below that shows all of the animals Dexter saw and explain why the others are incorrect.




