English

Maths

In maths this half term we will be learning about mass, capacity, temperature and money.

We will be using scales to measure the different mass of objects in the classroom.

We will be learning how we can add and take away using money in real life situations.

We will be learning how to read the scale on a thermometer to measure temperature.

This half-term we are reading:
