English

We are reading 'Cloud Tea Monkeys' by Mal Peet and Elspeth Graham. The children will be writing descriptions, letters and discussions. Their main outcome will be to write a non-fiction report.

Then we will be focusing on 'Small in the city' by Sydney Smith. The children will be setting descriptions, poems, diary entries, dialogue and letters of advice.

Maths

This half term in maths we will focus on:

Mass and capacity - Measuring comparing and order measurements using g and kg and l and ml.

Fractions – comparing and ordering unit and non-unit fractions, looking at fractions on a number line, and finding equivalent fractions.
