## Maths

In Maths we are studying units on decimals, negative numbers, converting units and volume.

This will include learning about:

- Adding and subtracting decimals
- Comparing and ordering negative numbers
- Converting between different units of length, weight and time.
- Estimating volume and capacity.

## Science
