- Understanding and using modal verbs.
- Exploring the passive voice and using it in our own writing.
- Understanding and using formal language.
- Writing and presenting speeches to the class.
- Creating news reports from historical reports.

Spring 1

RE

Our big question this half term is **'What does it mean to be a Buddhist?'**

We will be learning about the different beliefs and practices of Buddhism.

Science

We are learning how living things are grouped and classified. We will be investigating the binomial system created by scientist Carl Linnaeus.

History/ Geography

In History we are learning about Crime and Punishment. We will be investigating the significant changes in Crime and Punishment from the Anglo-Saxons to the present day.

Art/ DT

We will investigate a range of artists and create our own piece inspired by their work.

Music

We will be learning about classical music, studying Benjamin Britten.
