English

We will be reading *The Arrival* by Shaun Tan. Our learning will be focused on understanding and using a range of different grammatical features to create descriptions of characters and settings. We will also be reading *Windrush Child* by Benjamin Zephaniah. Our learning will centre around creating letters, poems and diary entries in role as different characters within the text. Our guided reading book is *Fly Me Home* by Polly Ho-Yen.

Maths

In Maths we are learning about: Number and Place Value:

We will be reading, writing and comparing numbers up to 10,000,000, as well as using number lines to order numbers and learning to round.

Converting Units: We will be learning about metric and imperial units of measure and to convert between different units.

The Four Operations: We will be learning about addition, subtraction multiplication and division as well as factors, prime, squared and cubed numbers.

RE

During our RE sessions, we will be learning about the Christian perspective of life and death.

Science

We will be investigating how electrical circuits can be changed. Children will have the opportunity to make and develop their own circuits as part of their learning.

Geography

We will be looking at 'How life in Spelthorne is similar to life in Melun, France'. We will be using maps to identify human and physical features of each area and identifying similarities and differences.
