English

In English we are learning to:

- Understand and use a range of prefixes and suffixes.
- Use relative clauses and relative pronouns.
- Understand and identify the difference between antonyms and synonyms.
- Use semi-colons to mark boundaries between independent clauses.
- Understand and use passive verbs.

Maths

In maths, we will be covering these topics:

- Fractions: finding equivalent fractions; comparing and ordering; adding and subtraction; multiplying and dividing; finding fractions of an amount.
- Converting units of measure: metric and imperial.

RE

In RE, our big question is: How do Christians advertise Christmas to show what Christmas means today? We will explore different advertisements and consider the difference between secular and religious views of Christmas. We will also consider the Gospel accounts of the Nativity.

Science

Our unit this half-term is light. The children will learn how light travels, be able to explain why we see things and investigate the shape of shadows.

History

Our big question is: Why is World War 2 an important part of British history? We will understand the causes of WW2; what life was like in Britain; key figures and how the war ended.

We will study a range of artists, exploring the meaning of paintings.

In French, we will learn how to say the date. In Music, we will explore songs of WW2.
