## Maths

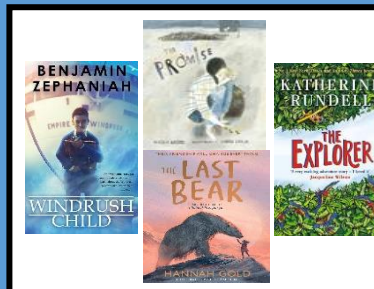
We will be covering these topics:

Fractions: finding equivalent fractions; comparing and ordering; adding and subtraction; multiplying and dividing; finding fractions of an amount.

We will continue work on improving our arithmetic skills and mental maths strategies.

In English, we are learning to:

- Understand and use a range of prefixes and suffixes.

- Use semi-colons to mark boundaries between independent clauses.

## Science

Our unit this half-term is light and we will answer the big question: How do our eyes help us to see? The children will learn how light travels, be able to explain why we see things and investigate the shape of shadows.

## History

Our big question is: Why is World War 2 an important part of British history? We will understand the main causes of WW2 and then explore how WW2 impacted different people and why it is considered a turning point in history.
