## English

## Maths

This half term we are learning all about:

Ratio and proportion: applying our knowledge of parts and wholes to calculate different amounts.

Algebra: learning about simple formulae and equations to calculate missing numbers.

Statistics: applying our knowledge of percentages to pie charts.

We will also be revising our knowledge of area, perimeter and volume.

This half-term

we are reading:



Across our English texts we will be exploring journalistic writing by identifying viewpoints and bias.

We will write from different points of view using the active and passive voice and have the opportunity to role play different characters.

We will also work towards writing our own version of a narrative applying our knowledge of the different tenses.

## Spring 2

## RE

Our big question this half term is **'How does the Christian festival of Easter offer hope?'**

We will be thinking about how the Easter story evidences hope, salvation and forgiveness.

## Science

We will be exploring evolution and inheritance with our big question: **'How have living things on Earth changed over time?'** The children will explore:

- how characteristics vary
- how plants and animals adapt;
- the process of evolution and what fossils tell us about the past.

## Geography

In geography, the children will study an area of the UK, identifying the physical and human features. They will also learn about grid references and how to use a compass.

This half-term, we will be developing our fitness levels and extending our volleyball skills.
