English

Maths

This half term we are learning all about:

Ratio and proportion: applying our knowledge of parts and wholes to calculate different amounts.

Algebra: learning about simple formulae and equations to calculate missing numbers.

Statistics: applying our knowledge of percentages to pie charts.

We will also be revising our knowledge of area, perimeter and volume.

This half-term we are reading:

Across our English texts we will be exploring journalistic writing by identifying viewpoints and bias.

We will write from different points of view using the active and passive voice and have the opportunity to role play different characters.

We will also work towards writing our own version of a narrative applying our knowledge of the different tenses.

Spring 2

RE

Our big question this half term is **'How does the Christian festival of Easter offer hope?'**

We will be thinking about how the Easter story evidences hope, salvation and forgiveness.

Science

We will be exploring evolution and inheritance with our big question: **'How have living things on Earth changed over time?'** The children will explore how offspring and the characteristics they inherit vary; how plants and animals adapt; the process of evolution and what fossils tell us about the past. We will visit Natural History Museum and take part in a workshop to support our learning.

Art

In our art lessons, the children will be exploring how artists express ideas and how they use scale to do so. They will focus on street art and murals, with the outcome to produce their own graffiti tag.

PE

This half-term, we are learning more about the tactics involved in rugby, such as how to create space when attacking. We will also continue to develop our volleyball skills.
