English

Maths

This half term we are learning all about:

Shape: calculating angles in triangles and quadrilaterals.

Statistics: applying our knowledge of percentages to pie charts.

Position and Direction: plotting coordinates, as well as translating and reflecting shapes.

We will also continue revising prior topics ahead of our SATs.

This half-term
we are reading:



Using our main English text, we will be:

- Writing a letter of advice
- Using adverbials to describe an action scene
- Exploring the passive voice and using it to build tension.
- Planning and writing dialogue to advance action.
- Creating our own gothic narratives.

In Guided Reading, we will explore the features of non-fiction texts and use it to retrieve and record information. We will increase our understanding of political systems around the world.

Summer 1

RE

Our big question this half term is **'How has the Christian message survived over 2,000 years?'**

We will be learning about how the early Christian message spread and why Bible translation is important.

Science

We will be exploring the human body with our big question **'What makes us tick?'**

The children will discover the circulatory system and understand in greater detail the function of the heart, blood vessels and blood.

Geography

In geography, the children will recap and extend their mapwork skills. We will revisit the features of a map and look in detail at Ordnance Survey maps, including keys and contour lines. Finally, we will learn how to use 6-figure grid references and the eight compass points for directions.
