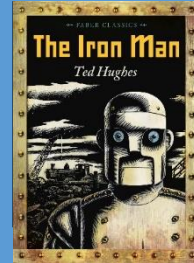
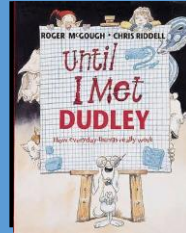
Our guided reading book is 'Tamarind and The Star of Ishtar'. We will make comparisons between life in India and the U.K. and develop our vocabulary.

RE

Science
