<p><u>Ready, Steady Reception</u></p> <p>During this theme we spend time getting to know one another and make lots of new friends. We talk about our families and what things we enjoy doing. We begin exploring our new environment and learn what it means to be a 'good learner' using our learning dinosaurs.</p>	<p><u>Let's celebrate!</u></p> <p>During this theme we learn about different types of celebrations. We learn about Guy Fawkes and Bonfire Night, Remembrance Day, Diwali, birthdays and Christmas. We look at how and why these festivals are celebrated. We explore how we have changed from one birthday to the next.</p>	<p><u>3,2,1 Blast Off!</u></p> <p>This is when we learn about our solar system. We learn about the planets, the moon and how astronauts travel into space. We look at different stories relating to space and imagine we are on a journey to the moon, exploring our ideas through role play.</p>	<p><u>Once upon a time...</u></p> <p>During this theme, we look at a variety of traditional tales; discussing the different characters and events that take place. We retell stories using puppets and make up our own stories. This half term we will visit our local library as part of our curriculum enrichment.</p>	<p><u>Australian Adventures</u></p> <p>This half term, we follow Koala and Kangaroo as they jet off on an Australian Adventure. We use a globe and maps to see where Australia and England are. We look at Australian animals and compare climates. On their way back, Koala and Kangaroo visit Buckingham palace and we begin to learn about the King.</p>	<p><u>Marvellous Minibeasts</u></p> <p>During this theme, we look at a variety of different minibeasts. We take the opportunity to go outside and investigate the world around us. We learn about lifecycles and observe different habitats. This half term we go on our first school trip where we do some animal handling and pond dipping.</p>
