



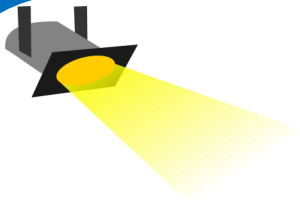

Give me 2 reasons why they might feel this way. □ What does the word _____ suggests/imply/tell you?

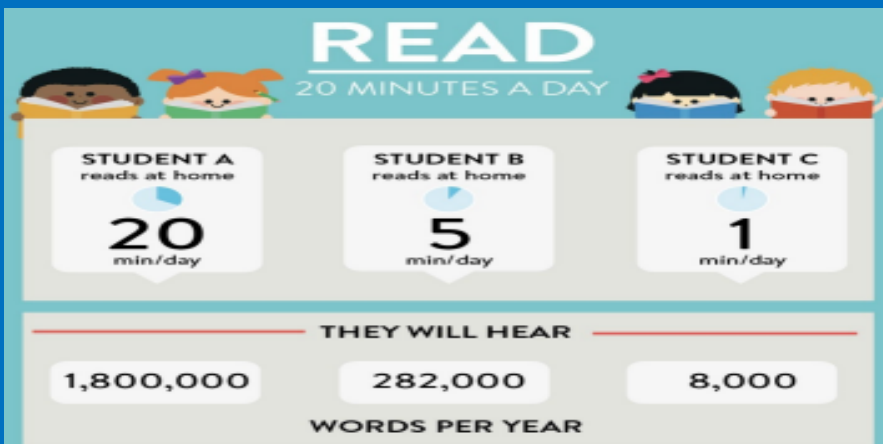
What do you think _____ might do next? Why?

Ask your child questions about what they have been reading to check their understanding and record this reading in their reading record. Children in KS2 can write their own comment about what they have read.

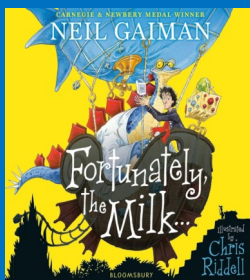
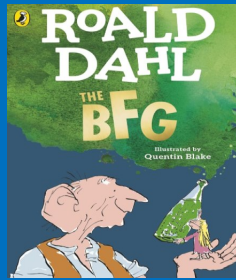
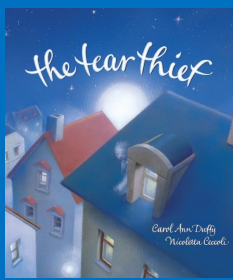
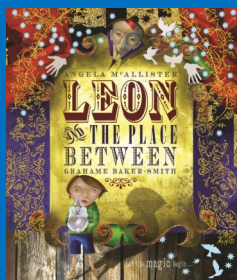
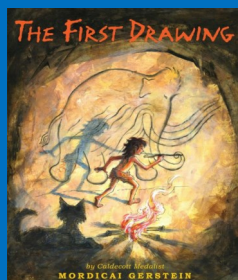


Reading Volunteers

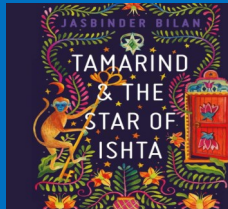
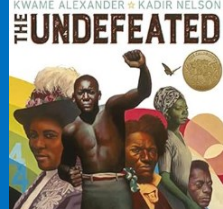
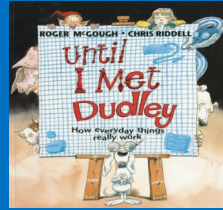
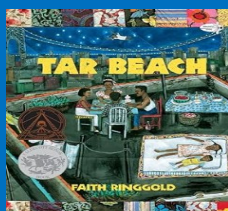
