How is Maths taught at ACE?

At ACE we follow White Rose Maths which provides a progressive and consistent curriculum across the school. This is designed to develop children's knowledge and understanding of mathematical concepts through carefully sequenced small steps. Across the school, children use a range of practical resources to support their maths learning.

Recent Learning in the Infants

Year 2 have started learning all about multiplication and division. They have been developing their knowledge of grouping and sharing in to equal groups by physically creating these using counters and cubes.

They have also been learning about doubling and halving numbers which supports them with understanding how to multiply and divide by 2.

Recent Learning in the Juniors


Year 6 have been revisiting prior learning on decimals, and focusing on their reasoning skills. They have been developing their knowledge of how to add, subtract, multiply and divide decimals by whole numbers.

They have also been learning about rounding to the nearest hundredth, tenth and whole number.

This learning will support them when they begin to learn about the equivalent fractions,







How can you support your child with writing at home?

Number and place value knowledge are needed for all areas of maths such as fractions and shape, space and measure. To support your child at home you can be practising: counting forwards and backwards, comparing numbers, learning key number facts such as bonds to 10,100 and 1000, talking about and handling money and telling the time. Maths is all around us so also try to talk about maths when doing every day activities such as shopping, cooking and scheduling the day ahead.
