However, we have noticed more and more recently that children are wearing track suits with brand names splashed across them.


Please remember that the correct school PE kit should be a plain, dark coloured track suit. These can be purchased fairly cheaply in any of the supermarkets or Primark or Matalan. Please see below excerpt from the school Year Book.

#### PE Uniform

### Children should wear PE kit to school on the days their class has PE

- White round-necked shirt (school logo or plain)
- Black shorts (not lycra cycling shorts)
- Black plimsolls
- Years 3,4,5 and 6 are in addition to plimsoles permitted to wear suitable plain trainers (not coloured Astroturf trainers) for outdoor PE only
- Plain black/navy tracksuits are optional for outside winter PE/Games lessons. No large logos/pictures please
- School socks white, grey or black

T-shirts in house colours should ONLY be worn for sports day and other house events (available from the PTA  $\pounds$ 3.50 each
