WHAT an amazing school of book characters we had this week on World Book Day. The costumes were fabulous. Well done to all our parents for making your children look so great.

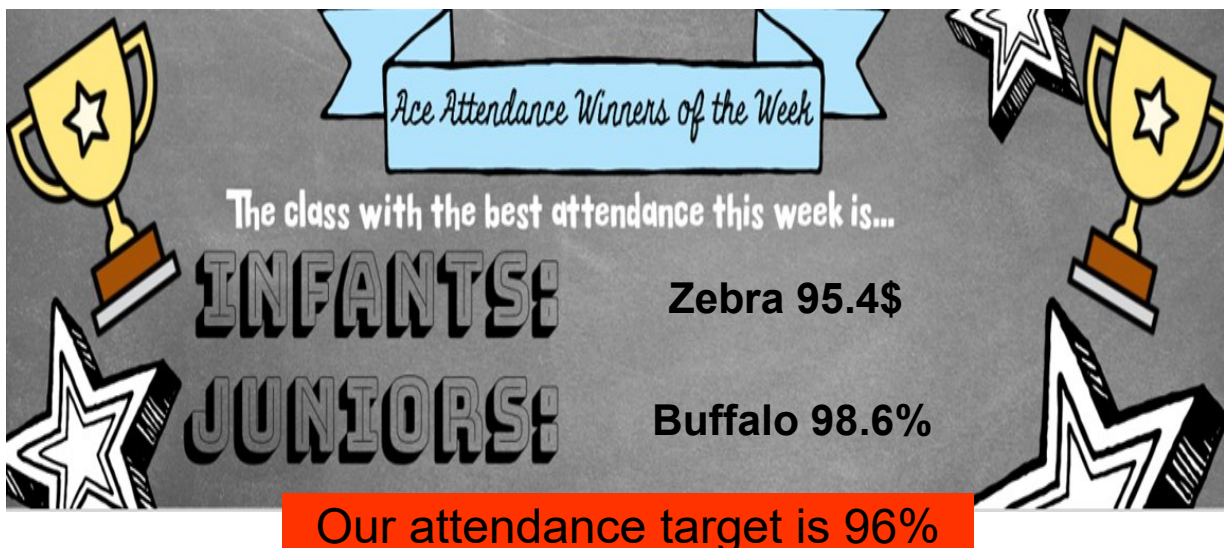
