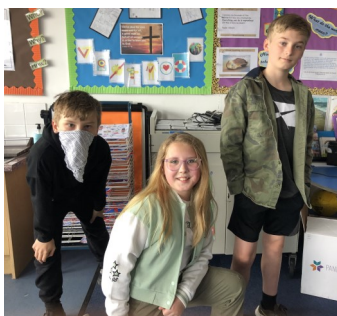
It's in the Stars

The children also got to walk along the historic Prime Meridian line which separates the eastern and western hemispheres of the earth.

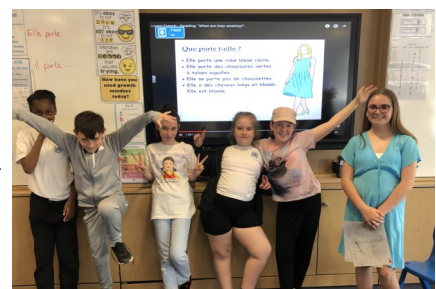


Défilé de mode française
