Once a Week, Take a Peek!

THERE have been some cases of head lice in school this week. It is inevitable that occasionally there are cases of headlice in school. Help us keep it to a

minimum by checking your child's hair regularly. Children DO NOT have to be away from



school for Headlice. As long as they have been treated they may come to school.

Penalty Notice for Unauthorised Absence

JUST to remind parents/carers that if they take their children out of school without authority for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive), they will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Currently the amount payable under a penalty notice is £60.00 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter the amount increases to £120.00 if paid between 21 and 28 days. If the penalty notice remains unpaid after 28 days, the Local will consider Authority а prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Please note that penalty notices are issued per parent/ carer per child so a family of two parents and two children will receive 4 penalty notices.


Too Sick for School?

you should send them to school or not. The QR code will take you to a page from the NHS with some great advice on when you should come to school and when to stay at home.




