past. Afterward they waited for a 'good bus' to bring them back. We were super proud of all the children. Their behaviour was amazing and they represented our school really well.



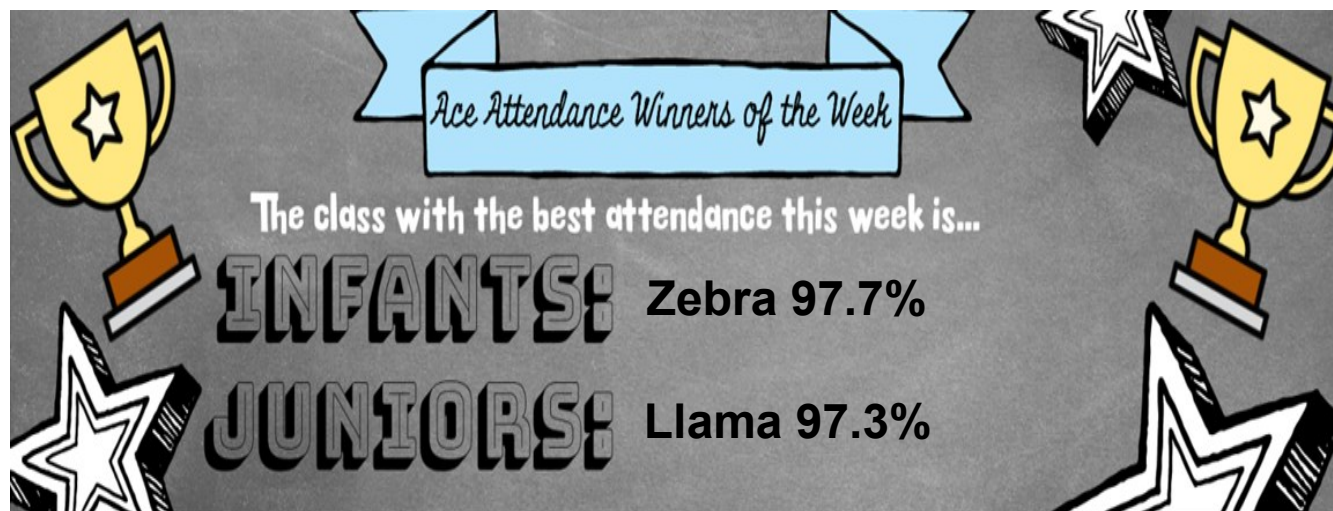
Bag2School
