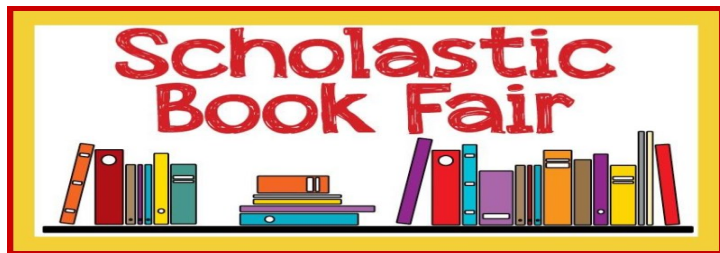

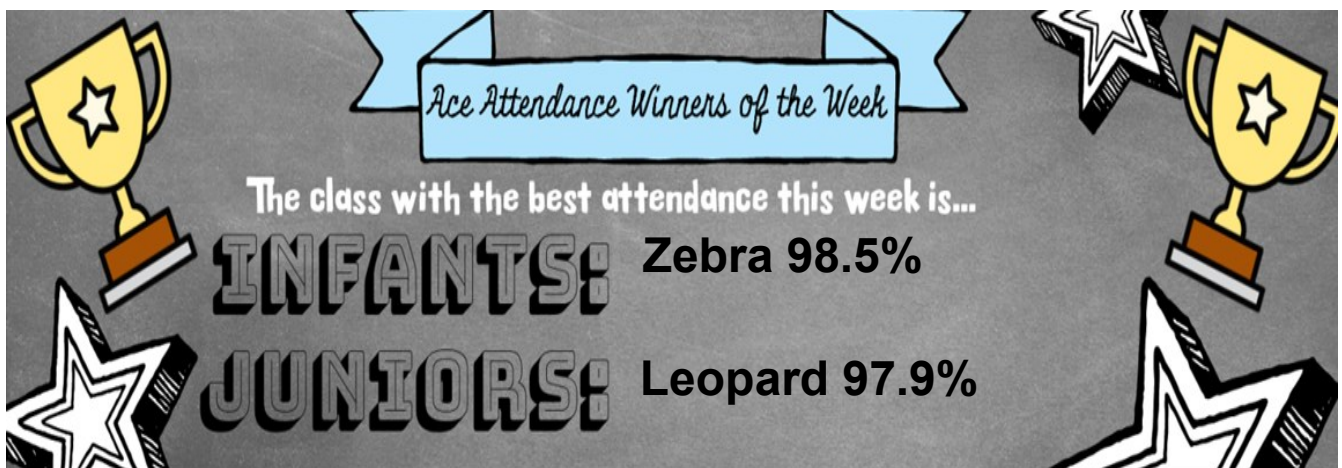
The way we were
