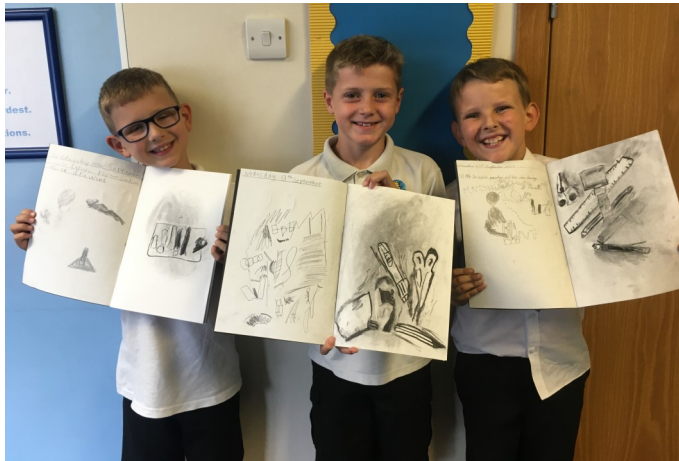
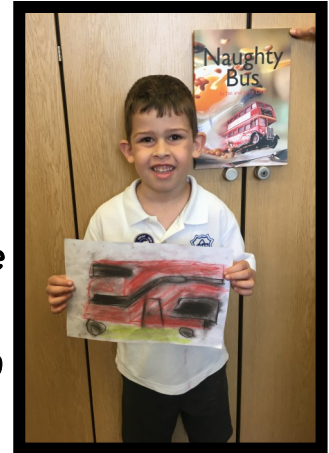

Ordering School Lunch

As we approach the colder months we usually find that there is a higher uptake for school dinners so we would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the procedure for ordering.

The lunch menu is a 3 week rotation and can be found on our website. The menu will change at October half term so look out for a new menu coming home in the next few weeks.

You must make your order one week in advance of your child needing the dinner. This allows our kitchen to be efficient when placing their food orders.

All children in Reception to year 2 are entitled to a free hot lunch. Parents who are in receipt of income based benefits may also be entitled to free lunch. **If you think you may fall into this category please speak to the school office.**

If you are entitled to free school meals, either infants or juniors, please do not order the meal and then send a packed lunch. This means the kitchen are wasting food and this is an added cost for the school.

If you forget to order your child's food, please let the office know or send them with a packed lunch. We have had to provide up to 15 extra lunches on some days and this makes it hard for the kitchen to know how much food to cook.

As always we are grateful for your cooperation. Please speak to the school office if you have any trouble with ordering or our online payment system.

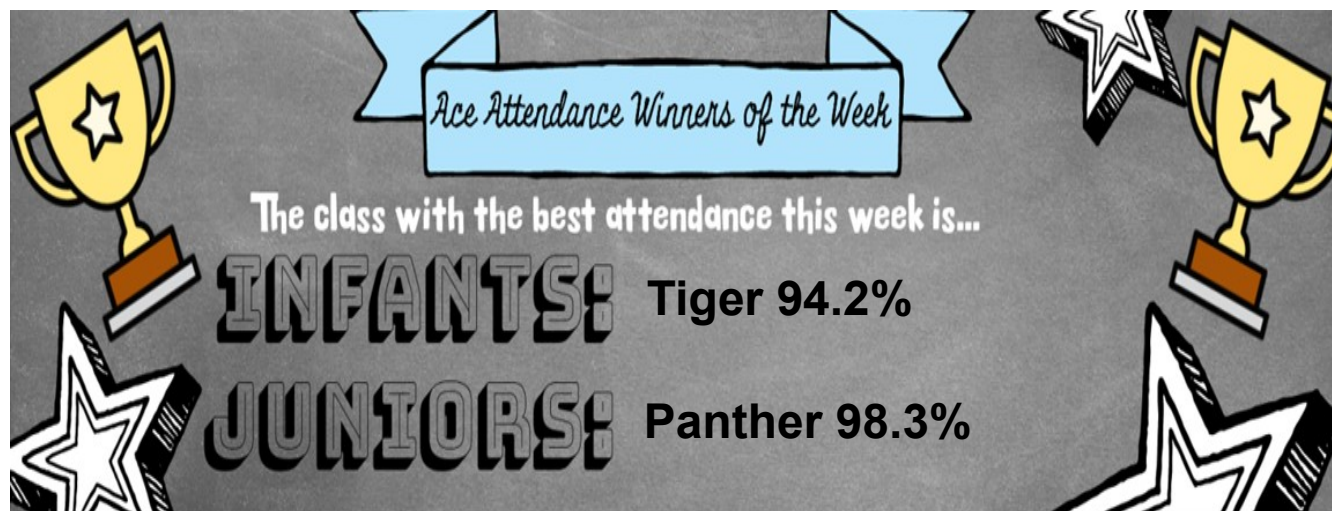


Parking and Driving Awareness
