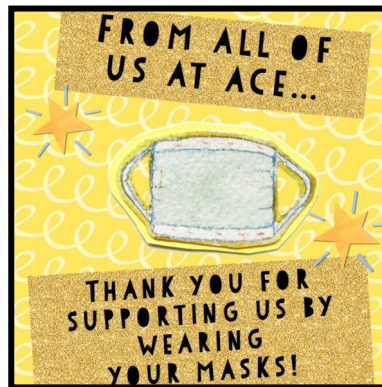




Stay safe, stay healthy
