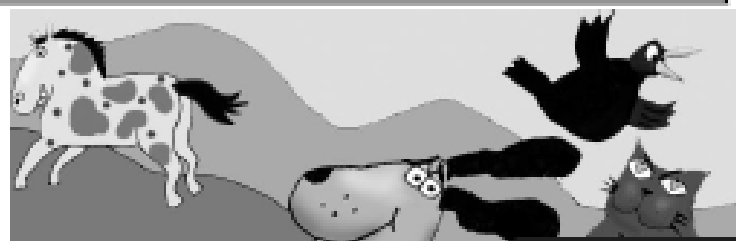
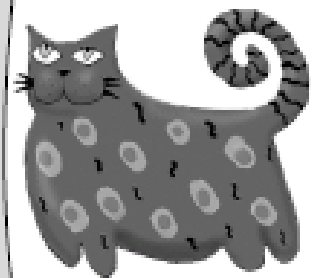
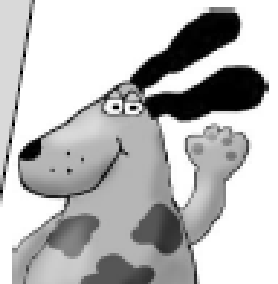
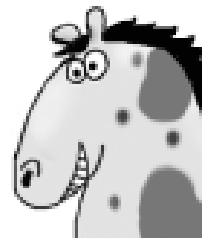
### GALLOPING STILL
