They ate some porridge, sat in some chairs and fell asleep in a little bed.



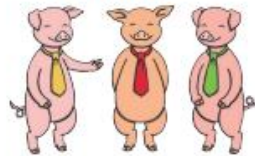
As they crossed over the bridge, a hungry troll jumped out!
