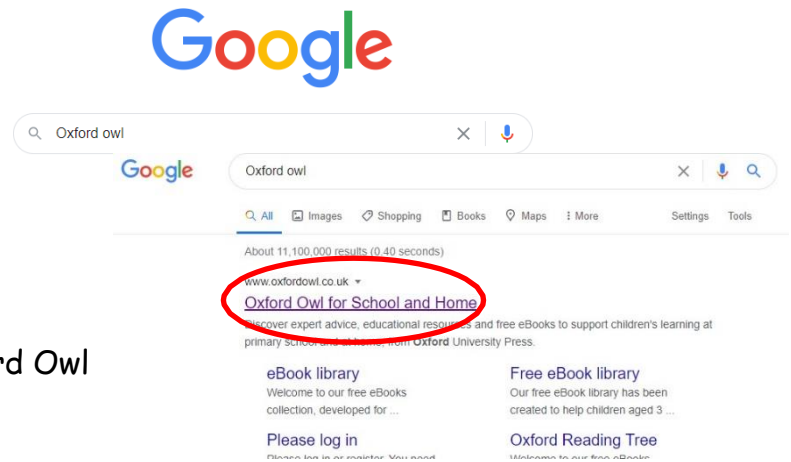


Oxford Owl e-books website

Open Google and type in 'Oxford Owl'.

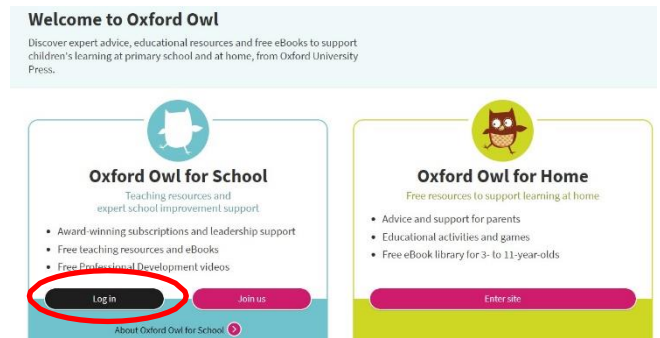


Step 2:

Click on the 'Oxford Owl eBook Library'.

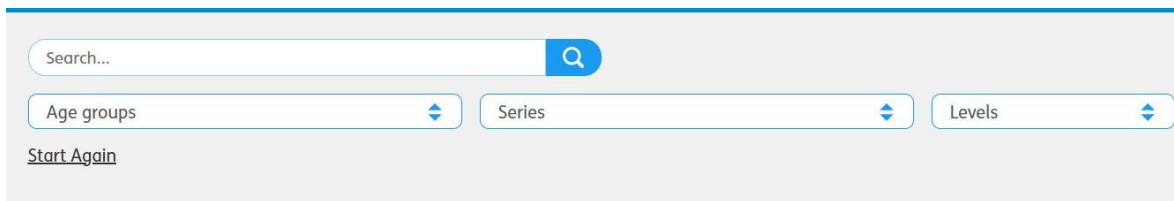

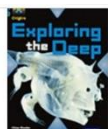

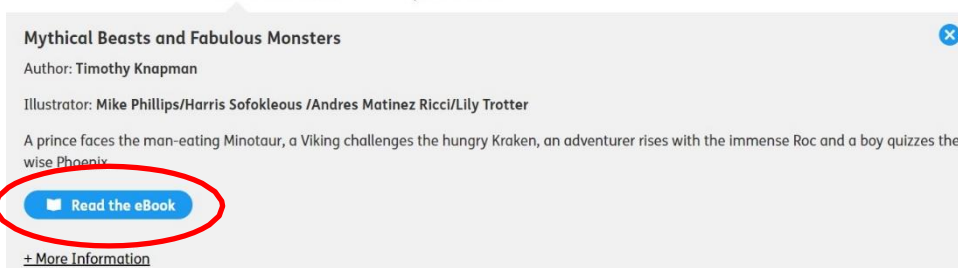
