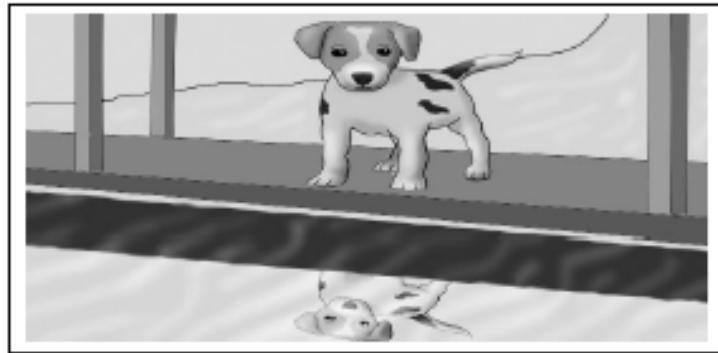


## THE DOG AND HIS REFLECTION
