

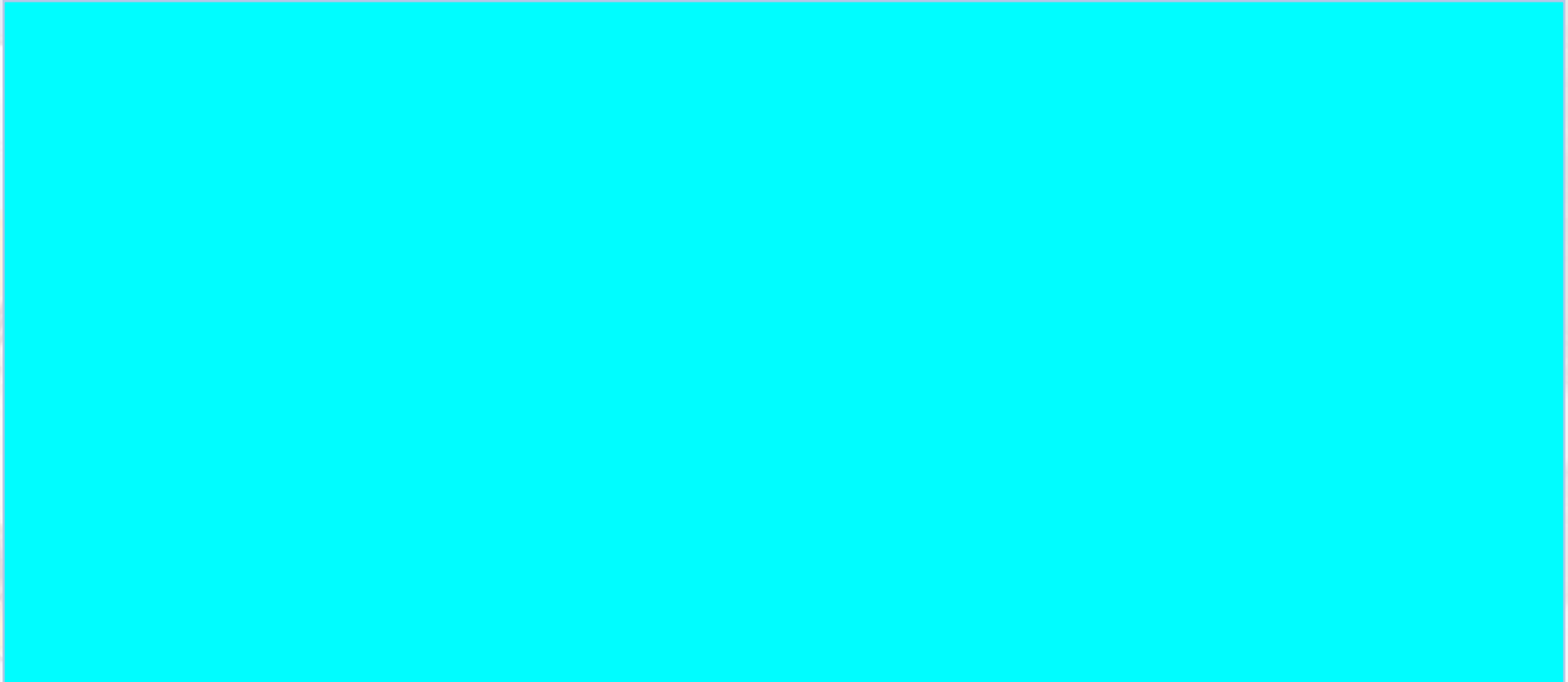

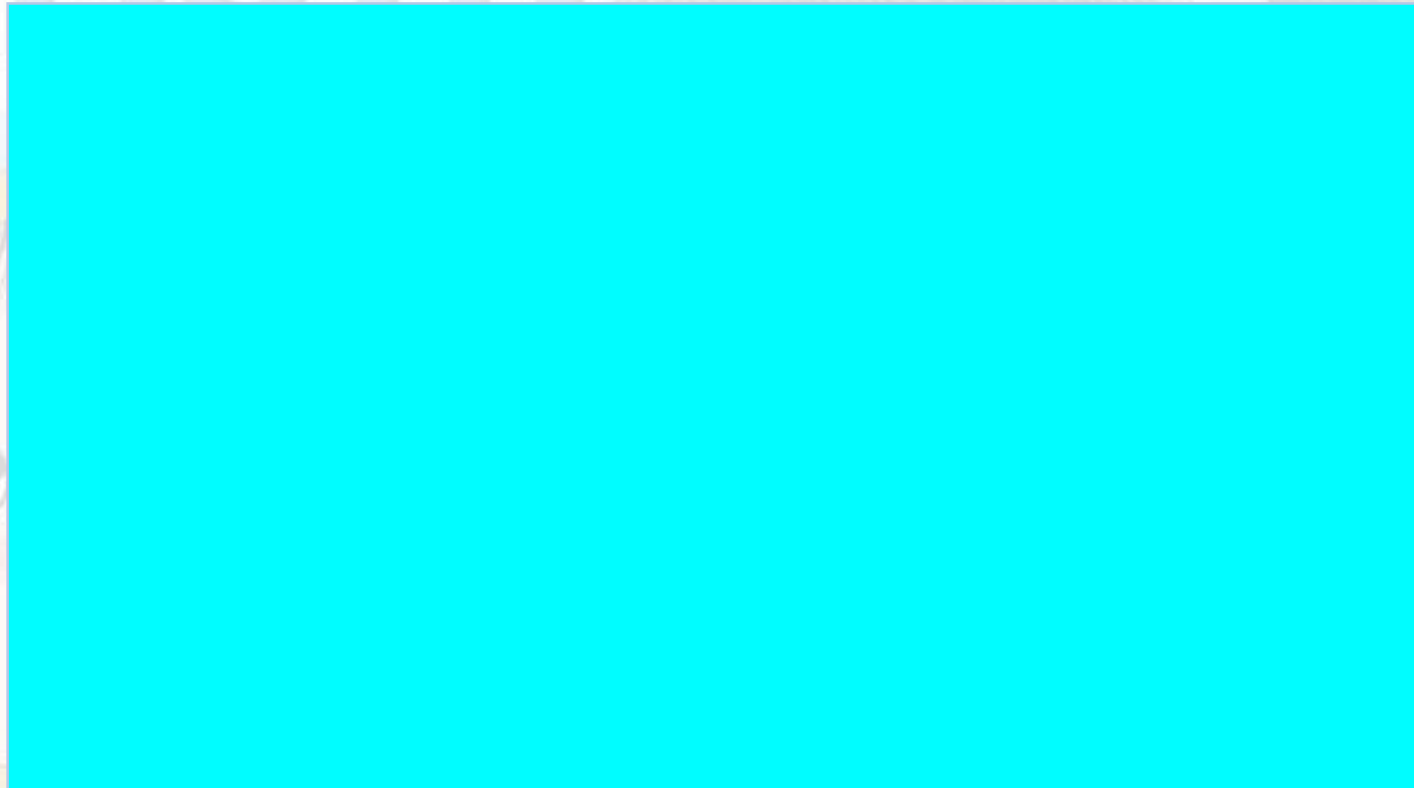
Instructions are a type of explanation text.

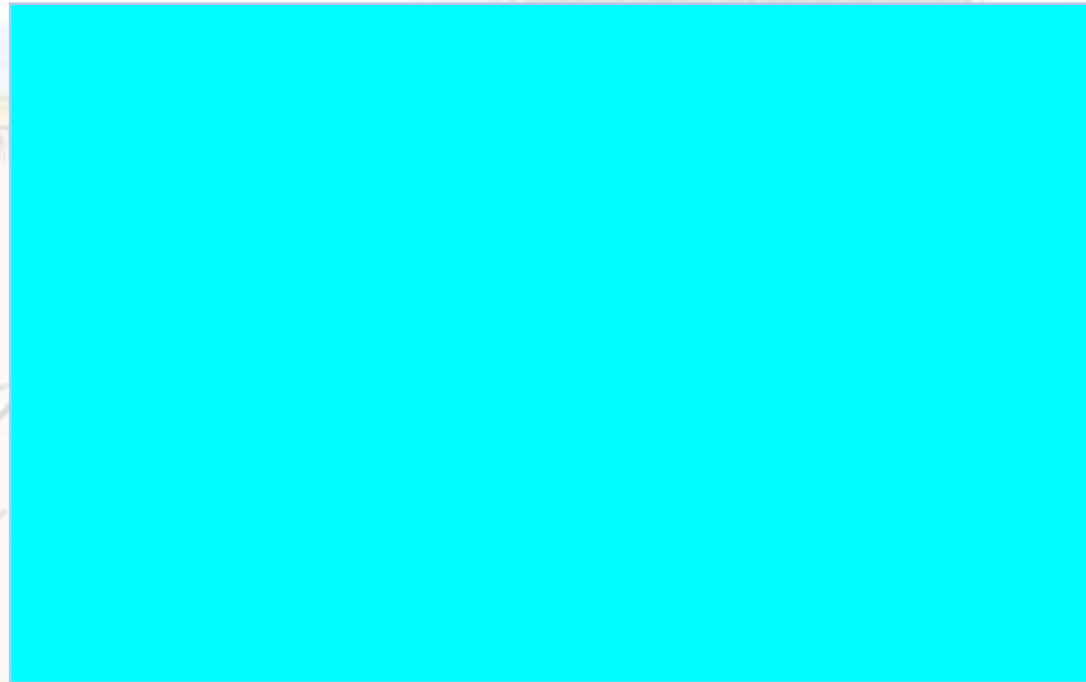

adverbs for **how** your woolly mammoth runs away

Does your woolly mammoth get stuck in a tree or does something different happen next?

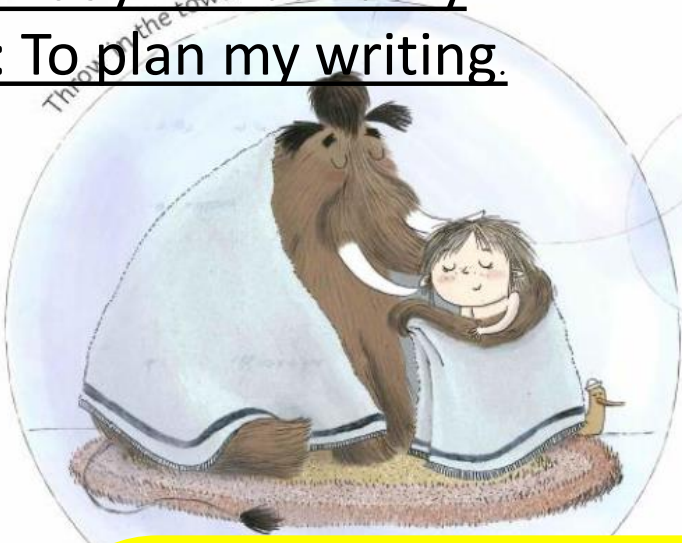
adverbs for **how** you will try to get your woolly mammoth back
