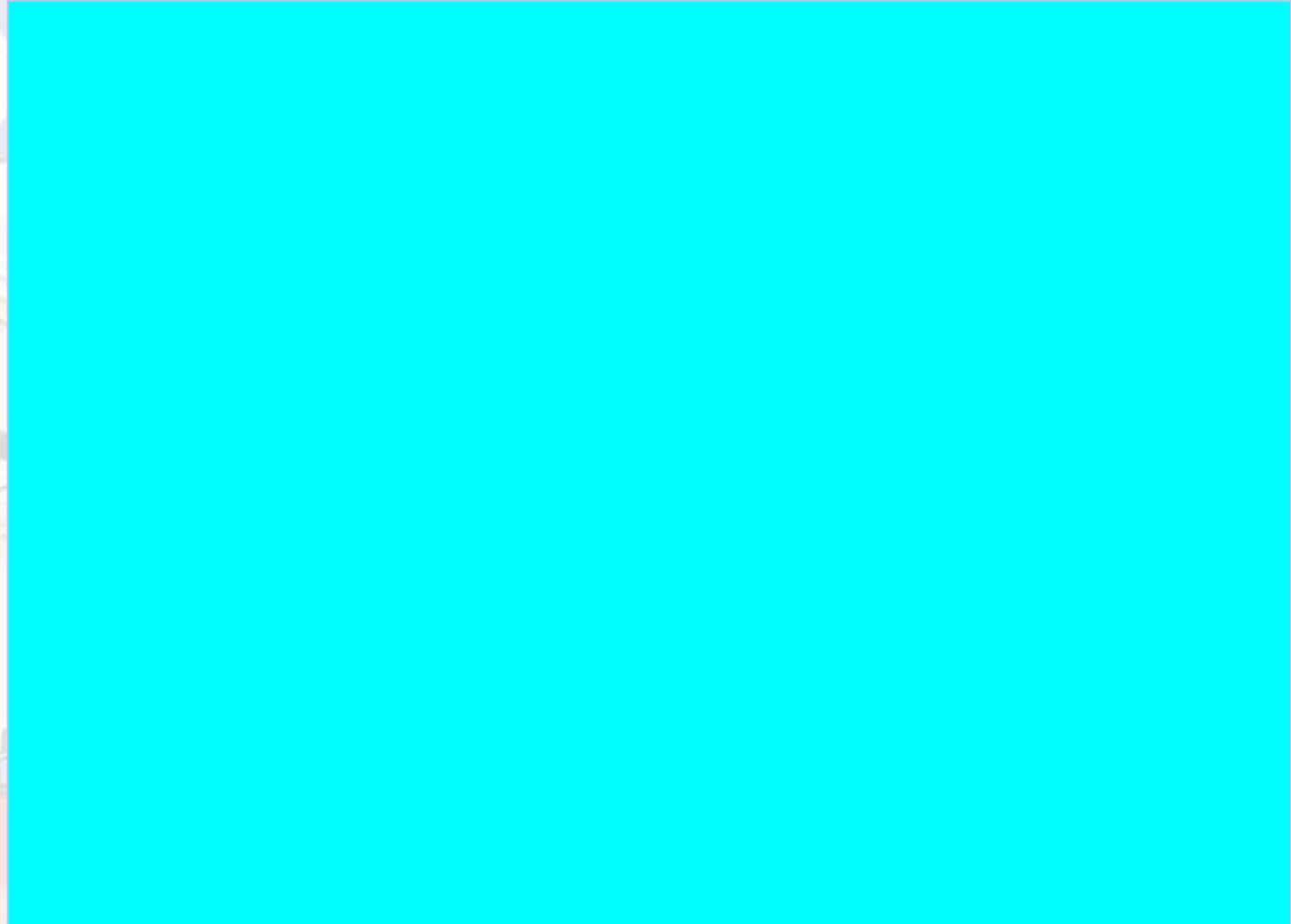

3. **Although** mammoths have **matted, knotted** hair, your must always scrub them **gently**.
