

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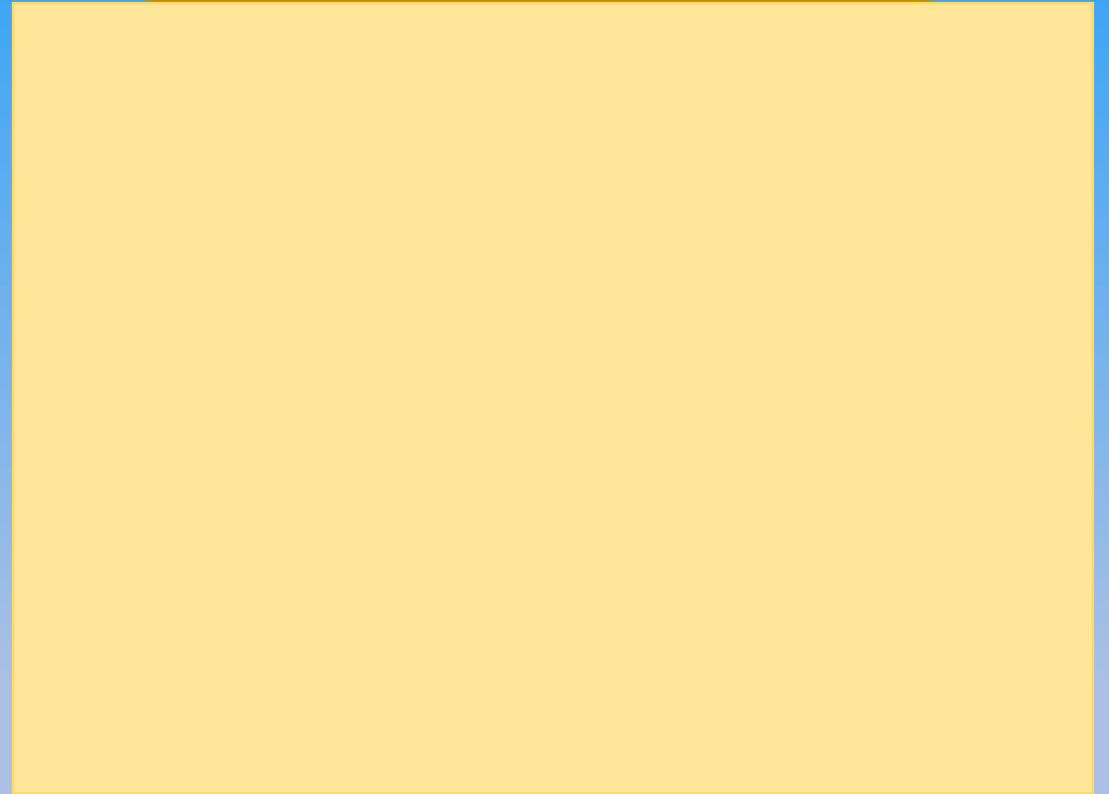

A poem is a piece of writing that expresses feelings and / or ideas and is written in a special way such as with rhythm, rhyme, a pattern or using lots of imagery.



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A question poem

A pattern where each stanza begins with a question.

Acrostic poem

The first letter of each line in an acrostic poem spells out a word.

I am **red fox** - when do you hear me?

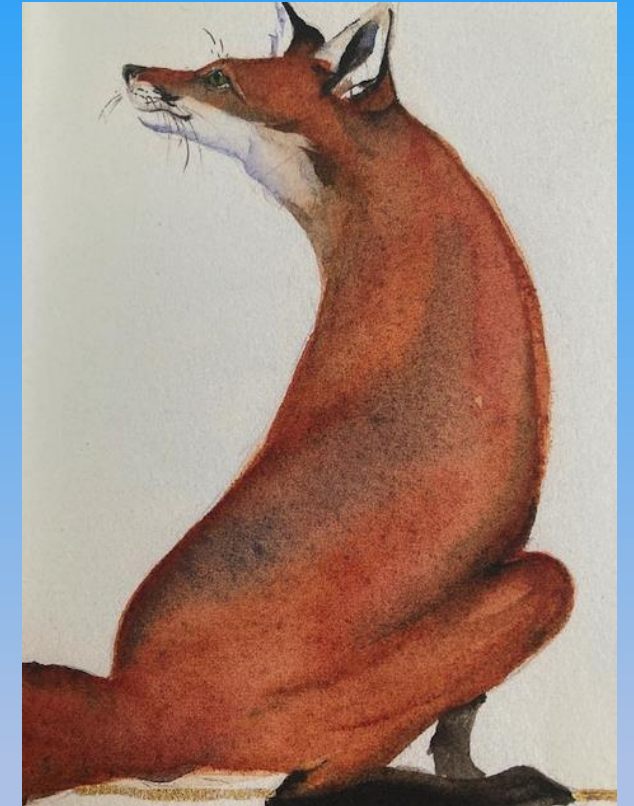
A scream in the night,

live-wire curves of force:

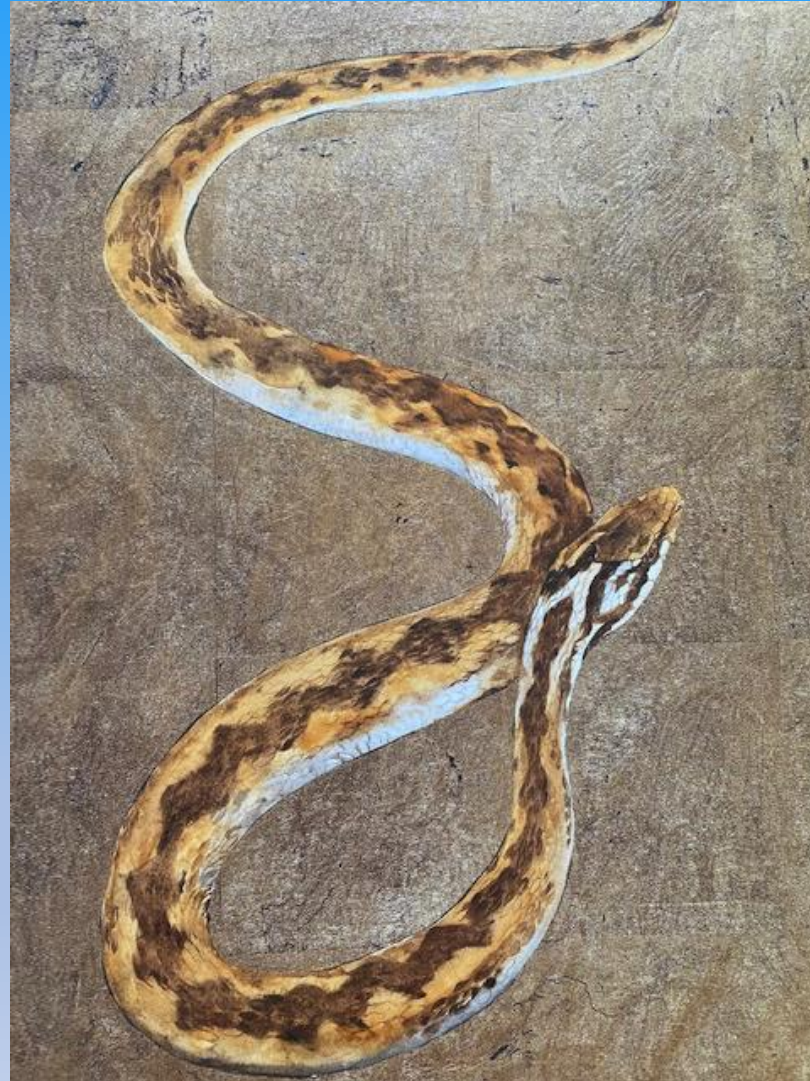
*For adder is as adder glides.*
