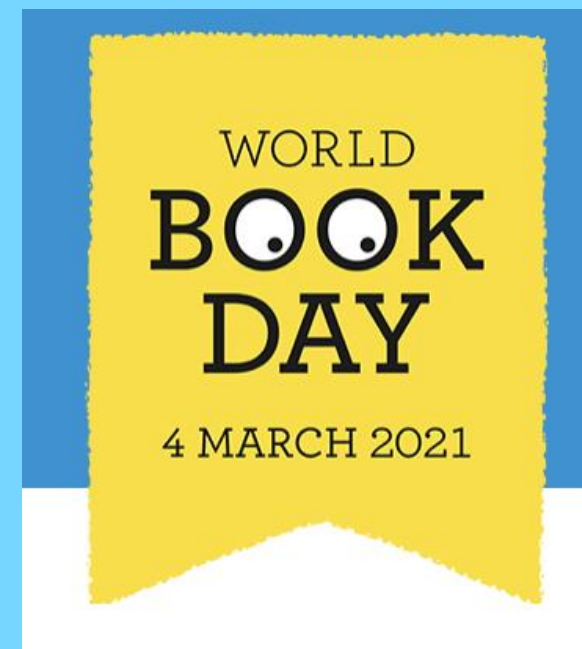
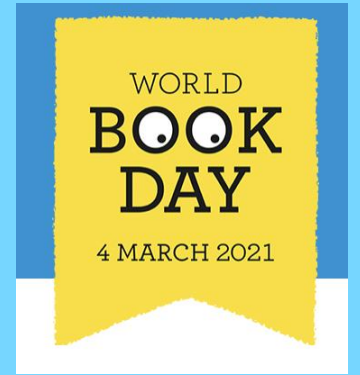

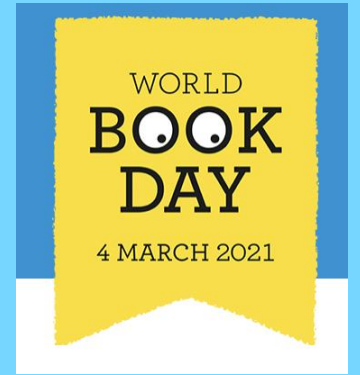


We are going to continue our World Book Day celebration by learning some tips from author and illustrator Johnny Duddle.

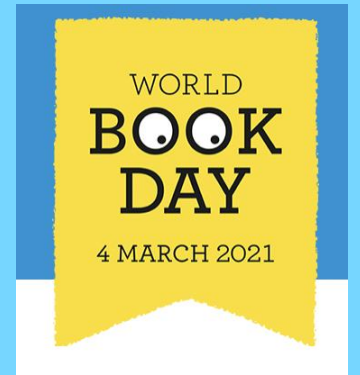

Your task today is to take some inspiration from Johnny Duddle...

INSPIRATION 1: DRAWING WHAT'S AROUND YOU

In the video, Jonny talks about how, since he was a child, he has enjoyed drawing the things around him – like birds and plants and trees. Sometimes he even imagines things to draw, like dragons, trolls and goblins!

- What can you see around you that you might like to draw? Go on a treasure hunt to find some inspiration for things you could draw.
- On a large sheet of paper, practice drawing the things you can see. Before you commit pencils or pens to paper, you might want to use string to trace the outline of your chosen things.
- Then, add some new things from your imagination. What sort of picture can you create from putting together all of your ideas?

Drawing what's around you.
Look outside, or if possible, take a walk and draw some interesting things that you see or imagine on your walk. It does not have to be dinosaurs, you could look for animals, fairies or anything else that interests you.
Add some notes to explain and describe the characters that you draw.
