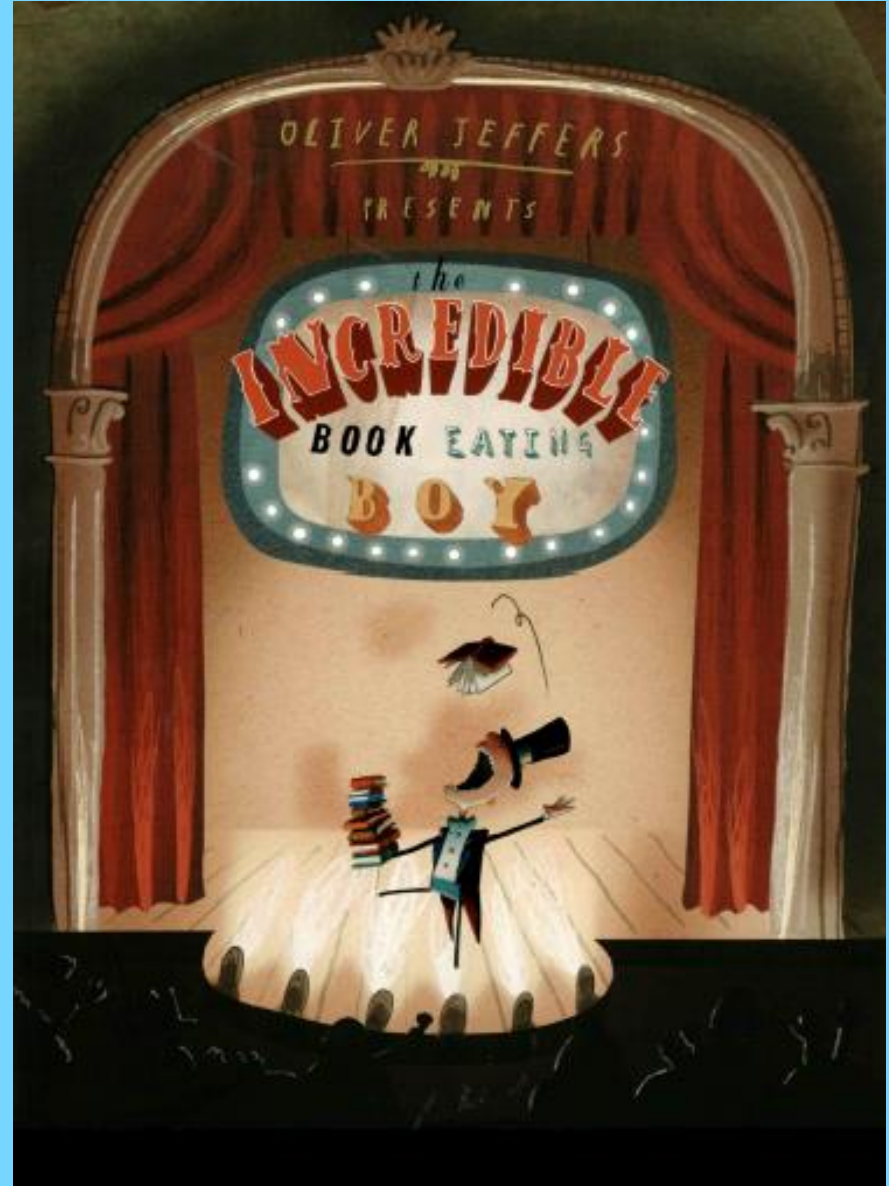
LO: To understand modal verbs.

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We can use modal verbs in our writing to try and persuade people. For example, in an advert.

What does persuade mean?

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To **persuade** someone is to cause them to do or believe something.

When we try to **persuade** someone of something through our writing, this is called **persuasive** writing.

An advert is a kind of **persuasive** writing.

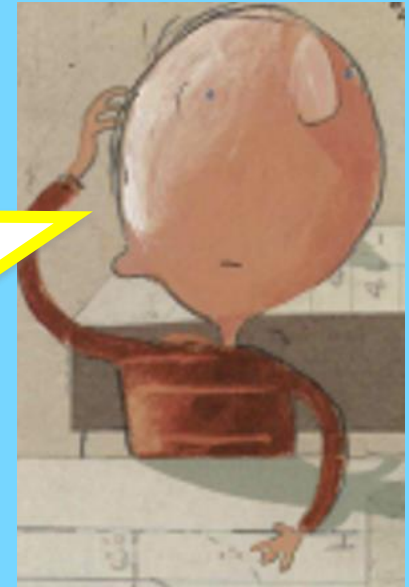

and superlatives

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A **superlative** describes something as the best by:

saying it is the '**most**' something.

For example, **the most scrumptious**

or by using an **est** suffix

For example, **the tastiest or the yummiest**
