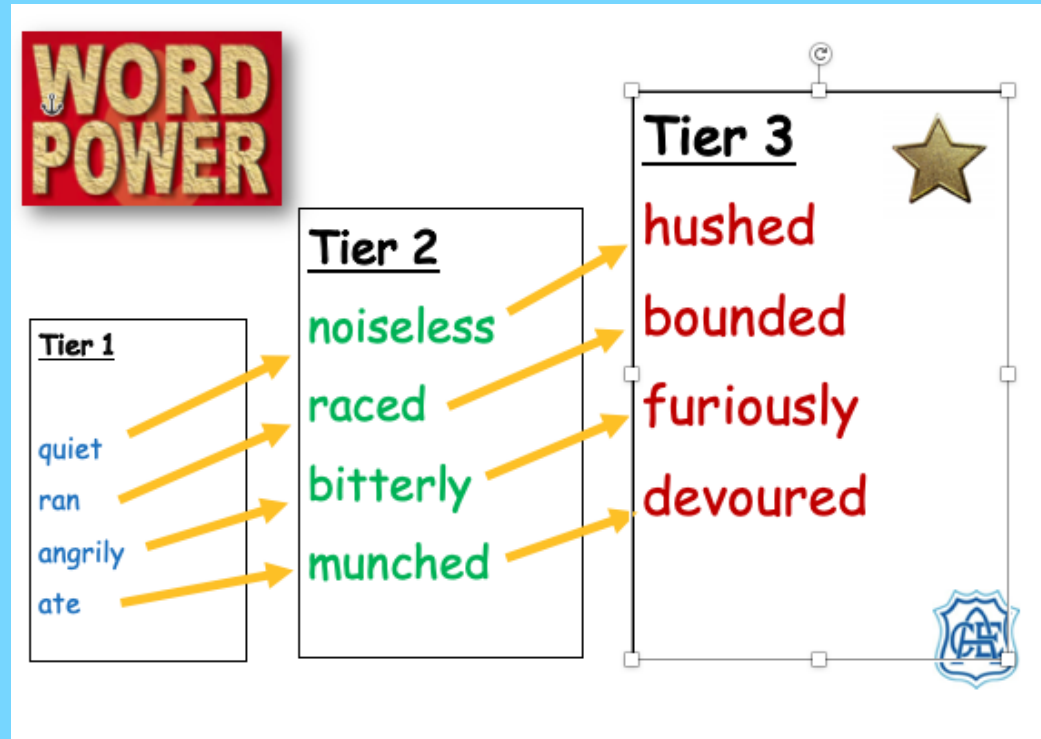

Modal verbs
show when things
are needed,
likely or
possible.

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Adjectives are describing words. In Year 3 we try to use tier 2 and 3 adjectives and to write expanded noun phrases by using two adjectives with a comma in-between them, before a noun.



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A **superlative** describes something as the best by:

saying it is the '**most**' something.

For example, **the most scrumptious**

or by using an **est** suffix

For example, **the tastiest or the yummiest**

What is a superlative?
