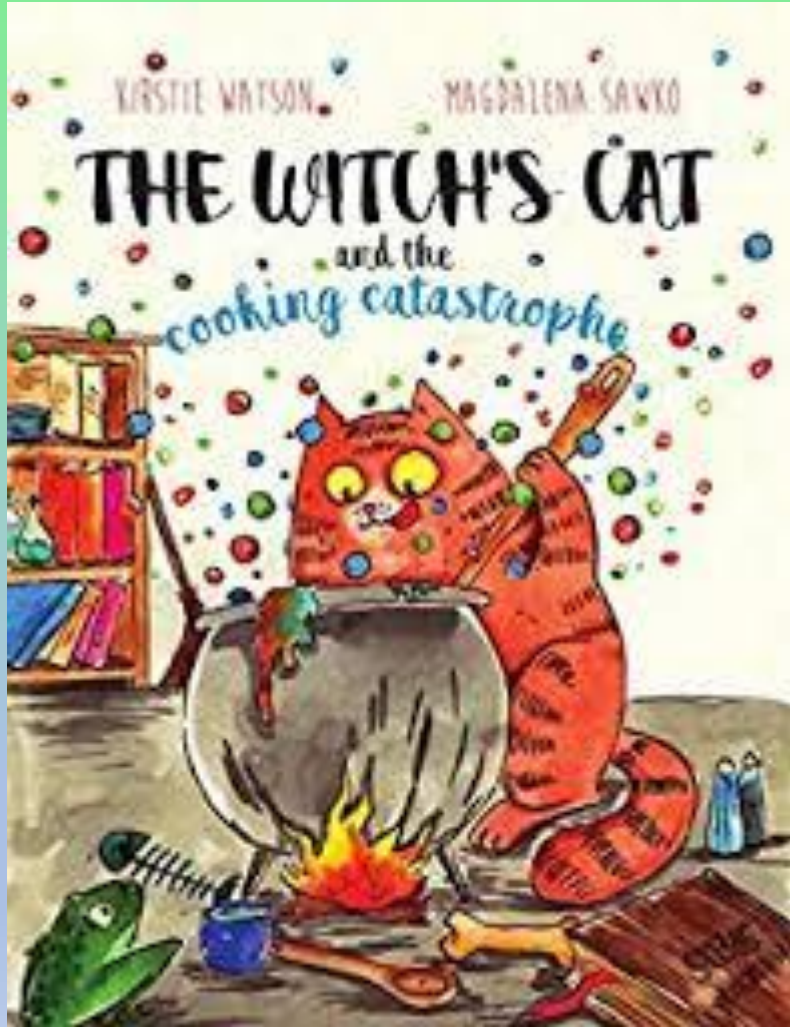

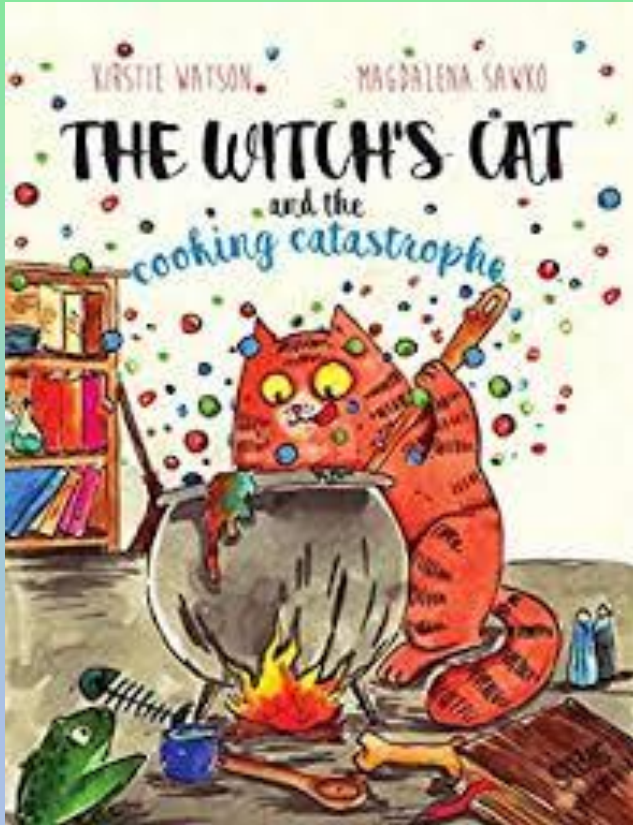

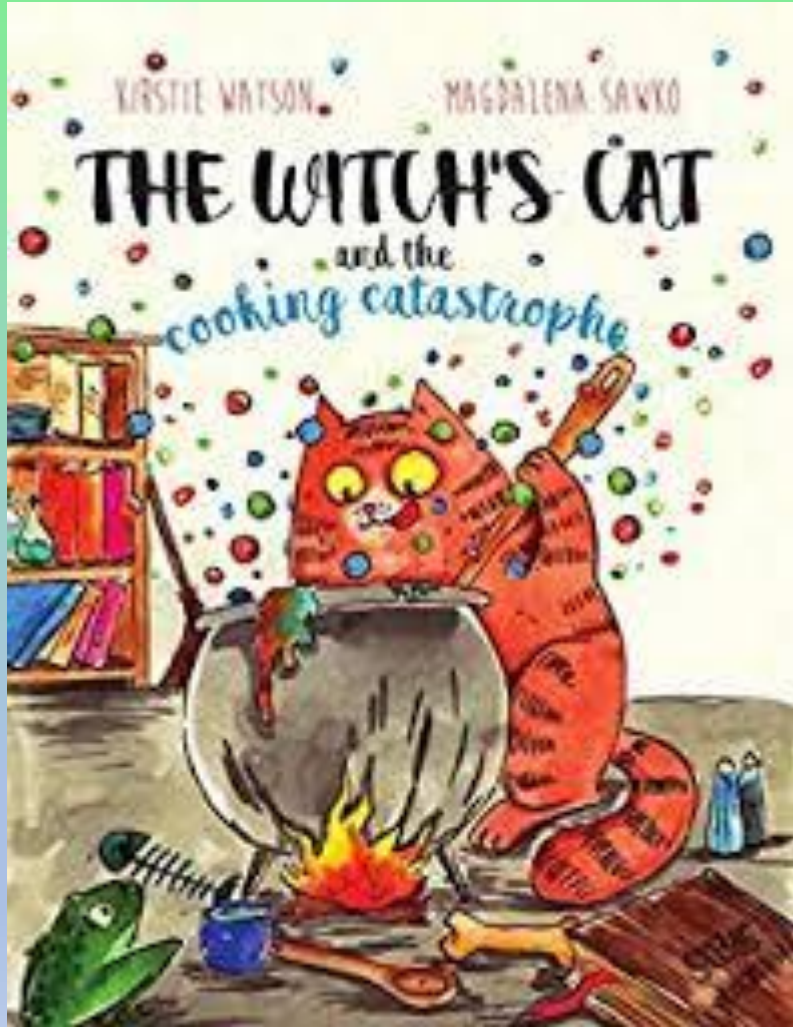

A time preposition
is a word or phrase

Wednesday 24th February

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A fronted adverbial is a word or phrase used at the **beginning of a sentence** that modifies the sentence by telling us **how, when** or **where** something happens.



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Here are some different ways in which we can use fronted adverbials:

-ing word

e.g. Shaking with fear, ...

Simile

e.g. Like a raging bull, ...

-ed word

e.g. Exhausted, ...

Adverb

e.g. Anxiously, ...

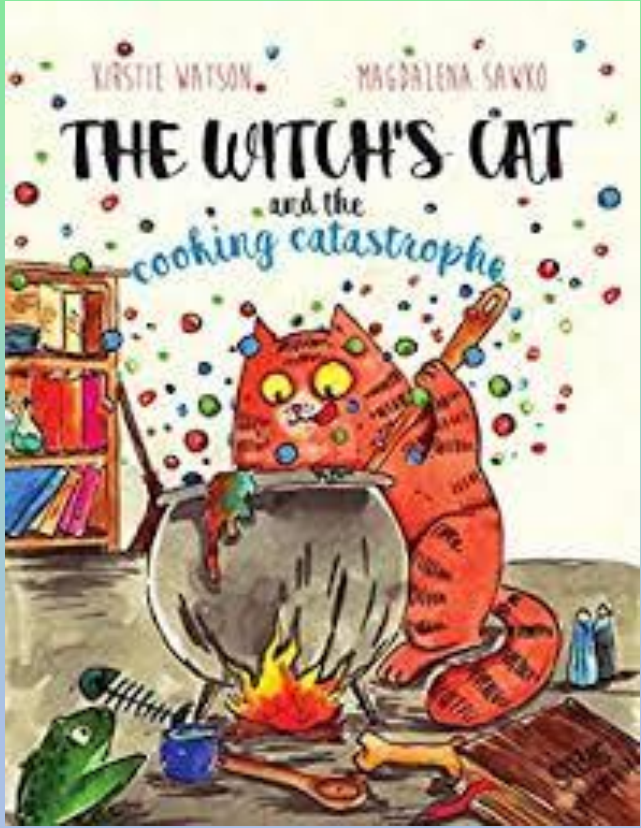

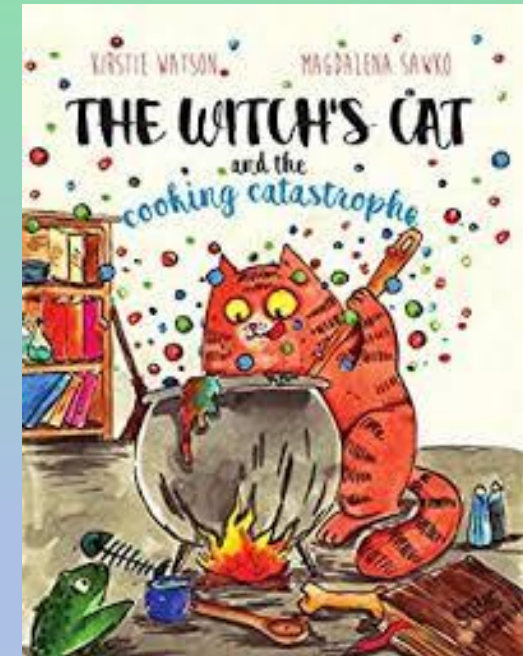

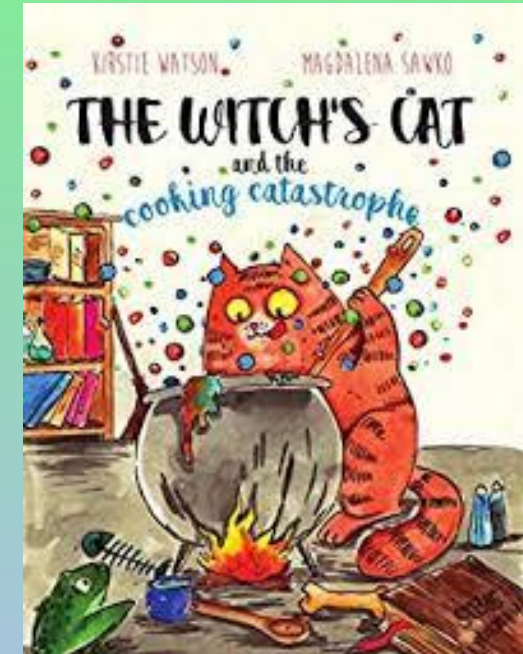
First of all, carefully add three spoonfuls of slippery, slimy frogs eggs into your pot and watch them wobble like jelly!

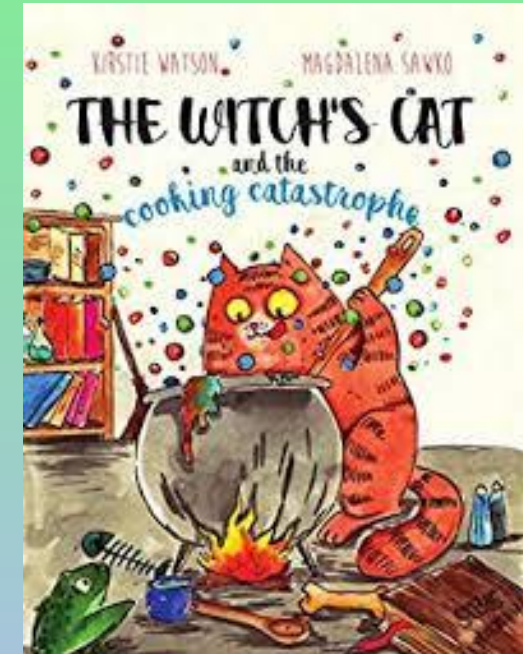

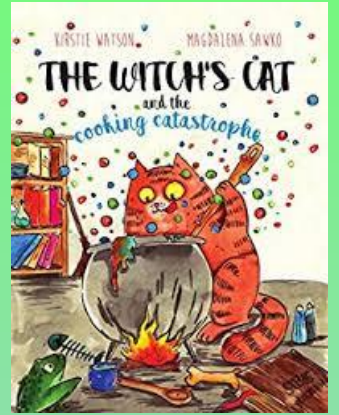

Potion directions
