Dear Parents and Carers,

We are looking forward to welcoming you and your children back to school at the beginning of the summer term on **Monday 19<sup>th</sup> April**, for hopefully a more straight-forward term ahead! We have lots of exciting plans for the children's learning and can't wait to get started.

We continue to keep our times of the school day under review, aiming to phase out staggered times eventually and return to the original times of our school day. All of this will be subject to DFE guidance and our own risk assessments going forward into the months ahead.

With all of this in mind, we are slightly revising the end times of the school day for Reception, Year 3 and Year 4 from Mon 19<sup>th</sup> April when our term begins. None of the start times are changing, but please note new end of day arrangements outlined below.

#### Mornings **No changes**

Reception classes – main gate entrance from 8:30am  
Year 1 and 2 – main gate entrance from 8:40am  
Year 3 and 4 – new hall gate entrance from 8:40am  
Year 5 and 6 – main gate entrance from 8:50am

Older siblings may still be dropped off with their younger brothers or sisters if required.

#### Afternoons

Classes will be released from the same doors as at present, but please note new exit arrangements for Year 5 and 6.

Reception class – finish at **3pm [change of time]**  
Year 1 and 2 – finish at 2:50pm  
Year 3 and 4 – finish at **3.10pm [change of time]**  
Year 5 and 6 – finish at 3.10pm **[now will be exiting from the hall door]**

Please be mindful that this continues to be an ever-changing situation, and we reserve the right to make future changes if needed, according to all current government guidance and expectations.
