Dear Parents and Carers,

As you may have heard this morning, our face to face Year 6 Leavers service will no longer be taking place on Monday 19th July. As disappointing as we know this is for many of you, we wanted to take this opportunity to explain the rationale behind this and the plans we have in place to make this the best end of year experience possible for our children.

Due to the bubbles closing last week, Year 6 have been unable to record their fantastic production of 'Treachery at Traitors Quay'; something that they have all been working so hard on and I know were incredibly keen to perform.

In order to maintain as many of our traditions, and give our pupils the experiences they so deserve, we will be filming the production on Monday morning, when the Leavers service was planned to take place.

Once recording has finished, the staff will then be organising and giving the children a little bit of time to put together and practise a leavers service. This will then be recorded and made available to you via our school website. We aim for this to go live by Tuesday.

With having the bubble close, we have very little time to ensure our children get to do all of these special end of school experiences. We are keen to get as much done for our children, with such limited time available to us.

Shirt and book signing will take place on Tuesday. We ask that the children bring in their own pens for this. Children will have Tuesday to pack away desks and belongings and we ask that they bring in a bag to bring home all of their wonderful creations that may be hiding in their trays.

The school day finishes earlier on Tuesday, with Year 6 finishing at 1.10pm. The Year 6's will be exiting out of the hall doors, as usual and will be joined by the year 6 staff. If your child has a privilege card, but you wish to come and greet them, then please feel free; however, we ask that you wait beyond the blue gates, in order to let Year 5 children, exit. Privilege cards will continue to be collected in at the end of this day. Staff will also be taking group photos on the day, which we will upload on to our school Facebook page.

We hope this helps alleviate any concerns or questions that you have regarding the children returning. As disappointing as it is not having our parents in for our Leavers service, we are at least grateful that we can have children back in to school at this time and carry on with all of our plans, in the limited time we have.
